



Catkin: an inflorescence (arrangement of flowers in a cluster or on an axis) with unisexual flowers, without petals, in a spike-like cluster; often pendulous. Catkins are illustrated below.

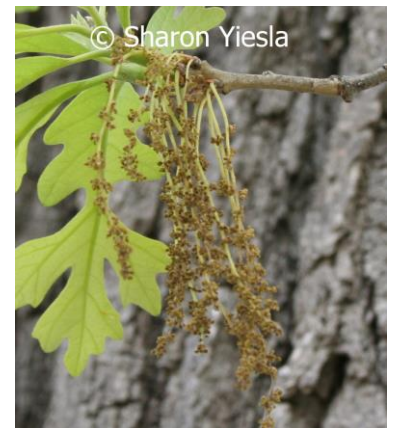
