



Corymb: A broad, more or less flat-topped inflorescence in which the outer flowers open first. Corymbs are illustrated below.

Achillea fillipendula (Fernleaf Yarrow). The branching structure of the corymb can be seen here. This is a complex corymb. Each branch ends in a head.



Alliaria petiolata (Garlic mustard). Note that the flowers on the outside have opened first.



Cardamine concatenata (Syn. *Dentaria laciniata*) (Cutleaf toothwort). This is a very simple corymb.
