



**Berry:** The entire fruit is fleshy and surrounds multiple seeds; septa (walls) may be present inside the fruit. Example: grape, tomato,

Tomatoes are thought of as vegetables, but botanically they are fruit, specifically berries.



Berries are not always edible. These berries of Jack in the Pulpit (*Arisaema triphyllum*) are poisonous.



Berries are not always round. This eggplant has an oblong shape.



Berries of some honeysuckles (*Lonicera* spp.) are considered mildly toxic and should not be eaten.
