



*Dicentra cucullaria*

Dutchman's Breeches (page 1 of 1)

The inflorescence is a raceme. The main stalk arches over, leaving the flowers dangling. The flowers have two white petals shaped like spurs and two yellow inner petals.



Fruits are capsules, pointed at both ends.



The form of the plant is low and mounded; 6 to 10 inches tall.



Leaves are basal and deeply divided to the point of being fern-like.
