



An Incomplete list of Hydrangeas Cultivars

***Hydrangea arborescens* (Smooth Hydrangea):**

- 'Annabelle': White flowers. Large flower clusters (8-12 inches across), containing mostly the showy sterile flowers. 3-5 feet tall.
- 'Hayes Starburst': White flowers. Leaves are dark green, narrow and wavy-edged. Flowers are doubles. 4-6 feet tall. May be difficult to find.
- Incrediball®: White flowers. An improved 'Annabelle'. Has large flower heads, with stems strong enough to keep them upright. (4-5 feet tall).
- Incrediball® Blush: Similar to Incrediball®, but with blush-pink flowers. Reblooms. (4-5 feet tall)
- Invincibelle® Ruby: Burgundy pink flowers; strong stems. 2 to 3 feet tall.
- Invincibelle® Spirit: Pink flowers. Blooms summer and late summer. 3-4 feet tall.
- Invincibelle® Spirit II: An improved version of Invincibelle® Spirit; darker foliage, stiffer stems, and larger flowers that are a richer pink. 3 to 4 feet tall.

***Hydrangea macrophylla* (Bigleaf Hydrangea)**

- Bloomstruck®: large clusters of deep rosy pink flowers on a compact plant (2 to 4 feet), stems and petioles are red-purple. Heat resistant. Blooms on both old and new wood. Part of the Endless Summer® collection. Zone 4
- Blue Enchantress: Beautiful deep red stems; large flowers (pink in alkaline soil, despite the name); reblooms. Zone 4. (3-5 feet tall)
- 'Blushing Bride': White (semi-double) flowers, blush pink with age. Mophead. Blooms on new and old wood. Zone 5. Part of the Endless Summer® Collection.
- Endless Summer®: Pink flowers (blue in acid soils). Mophead. 3-4' tall. Blooms on new and old wood. Inconsistent bloomer. Zone 4
- Let's Dance® Moonlight: Pink flowers (blue in acid soils). Mophead. 2-3'tall. Blooms on new and old wood. Burgundy fall color. 2-3 feet tall. Zone 5.
- Light-o-Day®: Lacecap. White showy sterile flowers on the outer ring surrounding small pink fertile flowers. Blooms on new and old wood. Variegated foliage. Zone 5
- Pink Elf®: Deep pink flowers on a small plant (18 inches tall). Zone 5.
- Summer Crush®: Deep pink flowers; plant size is 1.5 to 3 feet. Part of the Endless Summer® collection. Zone 4. New for 2019.
- Twist-N-Shout®: Pink flowers (blue in acid soils). Lacecap. Blooms on new and old wood. Burgundy fall color. Zone 4
- Wedding Gown ('Dancing Snow'): Double flowers are white (not blue or pink); repeat bloomer from spring to fall (spring flowering occurs if stems from last season live through the winter. Height is 2-3 feet. Zone 5? Part of the Double Delights™ series.

***Hydrangea paniculata* (Panicked Hydrangea)**

- Bobo®: Flowers heavily and early, with large flower clusters. White flowers age to light pink. Compact plant, only 2-3 feet tall.
- Fire light®: Large clusters of flowers emerge creamy white and age to a vivid red. 6-8 feet tall.
- 'Grandiflora': White flowers. 10-25 feet tall. Large flower clusters. The 'peegee' hydrangea.
- 'Limelight': Large flower clusters begin with a greenish cast, then turn white and finally age to pink. 6-8 feet.
- Little Lime®: Flowers like 'Limelight', but on a dwarf plant. 3-5 feet.
- 'Phantom': Pure white flowers in large clusters (up to 15 inches long); flowers mature to a pink tinge. 6 to 10 feet tall.
- Little Quick Fire®: Dwarf version of Quick Fire, growing 3 -5 feet tall. Like Quick Fire it flowers about a month earlier than other hydrangeas; white flowers age to deep pink.
- 'Pink Diamond': White flowers with pink. Pink color deepens with age. 6-10 feet
- Pinky Winky®: Flower cluster opens white. As florets at the base turn pink, new white ones are produced at tips. 6-8 feet.
- Quick Fire®: White flowers age to deep pink. Flowers about one month earlier than other *H. paniculata* cultivars. 6-8 feet
- Strawberry Sundae®: Showy flowers start white, turn to pink and then strawberry red. Similar to Vanilla Strawberry, but smaller (5 feet).
- 'Tardiva': Flowers white, aging to pink. Good flower color late into the season. 5-8 feet.
- 'Unique': White flowers that fade to pink. Up to 10 feet tall.
- Vanilla Strawberry™: Flower clusters start out white, then age to pink and then deep rose. 6-7 feet
- White Diamonds®: Clean, white flowers aging to light pink; heat tolerant; 4-6 feet tall.

***Hydrangea quercifolia* (Oakleaf Hydrangea)**

- 'Alice': White flowers, maturing to pink, in 12-14 inch clusters. 5-8 feet tall. Leaves turn burgundy in fall. Exfoliating stems.
- 'Munchkin': Large upright clusters of white flowers age to pink; burgundy-red fall color. Compact, 3 feet tall.
- 'Pee Wee': White flowers fading to pink; cluster 4-5 inches. Compact (2-4 feet). Fall color is red to red-purple. Exfoliating stems.
- 'Ruby Slippers': White flowers age to pink and then mature to ruby red; mahogany red fall color. 3 to 4 feet tall.
- 'Sikes Dwarf': White flowers in 3-4 inch clusters, fading to pink. 2-3 feet tall. Fall color is red to red-purple. Exfoliating stems.
- 'Snow Queen': White flowers maturing to pink. 4-6 feet. Large, dense, full flower clusters. Red-bronze fall color. Exfoliating stems.
