



The [inflorescence](#) is an [umbel](#). The stalk that holds the umbel bends over so the inflorescence is nodding.



Pinkish-white flowers; [perfect](#), with 6 [tepals](#); the 6 [stamens](#) are longer than the tepals and protrude. Flowers are small (1/4"); held in groups of 40-60. The [pedicel](#) (stalk) of each flower may be green or purplish



Leaves are [basal](#), up to one foot long, flattened, with smooth [margins](#) and parallel veins.



The plant, when in flower, can be 18 inches tall.



Fruits are [capsules](#), each containing a number of small black seeds. The capsules split open at maturity.
