



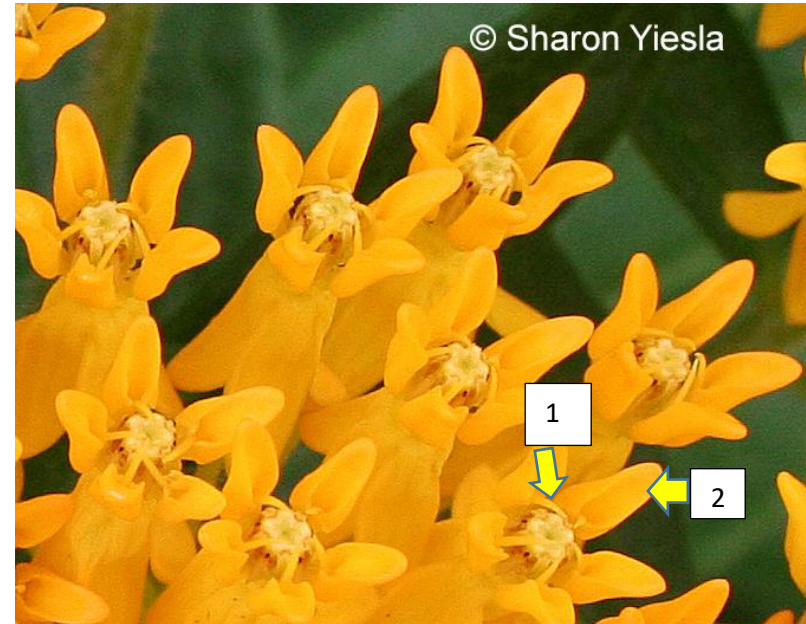
Perfect, yellow or orange flowers, very ornate (see close-up photos); numerous flowers held in rounded umbels.



Fruits are follicles, containing a number of seeds, each with a tuft of silky hairs attached (right). The follicles split open at maturity. Follicles are smooth.



Individual flowers are very ornate due to specialized structures (1. Horns and 2. Hoods). The male and female parts are fused into a structure called the gynostegium.



The plant is rounded to broad spreading; 1.5 to 2 feet tall.



The alternate leaves are sessile to nearly sessile. They are 2 to 3 inches long with entire margins. The purplish stem is pubescent.
