Marsh marigold (page 1 of 1)

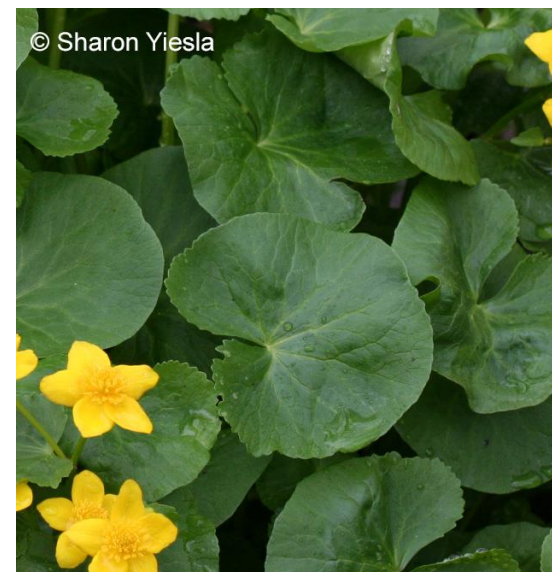
The [perfect](#) flowers are [solitary](#) or in small clusters. The petal-like [sepals](#) are bright yellow; a group of [pistils](#) in the center is surrounded by numerous [stamens](#) in a ring.



Fruits are small elongated [follicles](#) in a ring.



The form is loosely mounded; about 1 ½ feet tall.



There are both [basal](#) leaves and [alternate](#) leaves on the stems. They are kidney-shaped to nearly circular, with a shallowly toothed [margin](#) and deeply indented ([cordate](#)) base.
