

The [perfect](#), funnel-shaped flowers are held in a [helicoid cyme](#). They are pink in bud, opening to shades of blue (some plants will produce white or all pink flowers).



Virginia bluebells grow in a mounded shape. Height is about 1.5 feet tall.



The fruits are [schizocarps](#), nestled down in the persistent [calyx](#) (arrow). The long [style](#) of the flower can still be seen in this photo.



The [alternate](#) leaves grow up to 8 inches long, with an oval shape. [Petioles](#) are generally winged.
