



Wild Quinine has a compound [inflorescence](#). It is [corymb](#)-like and composed of [heads](#). Each head has 5 (short) fertile [ray flowers](#) (arrow) and numerous male [disk flowers](#).

The fruit is a [cypsela](#). The fruit forms from the fertile [ray flowers](#) (arrow)



The plant is 2-3 feet tall.

The [basal](#) leaves of the stem are in a [rosette](#). Each leaf is about 6 inches long. The leaves on the stem are [alternate](#) and much smaller. All the leaves have a rough texture.
