



The [inflorescence](#) is a [spike](#) of lavender flowers in four rows.



The lavender-pink, [perfect](#) flowers are tubular and [bilabiate](#); lower lip is three [lobed](#) and spotted. Four purplish [anthers](#) are seen near the upper lip.



Fruits are [nutlets](#) (4), enclosed in the persistent [calyx](#).



The stem is square.



The plant has an upright form and can grow up to 4 feet tall.



The [opposite](#) leaves are [sessile](#) and linear to [lanceolate](#), with [serrate margins](#).
