



*Ruellia humilis*

Wild Petunia (page 1 of 1)

The [solitary](#) flowers are lavender in color and resemble common petunias. The [corolla](#) is funnel-shaped with 5 lobes. The lower [lobe](#) is marked with purple lines. The gender parts (4 [anthers](#) and a [pistil](#)) protrude from the throat of the [corolla](#).

Fruits are two-sectioned [capsules](#) containing small, flat, oval seeds.



The [opposite](#) leaves have [entire margins](#) and are pubescent. They are [ovate](#) to almost triangular in shape. The stems are also [pubescent](#).

The plant has a spreading form and can form a ground cover. It grows to about 1 foot tall.
