Bush Honeysuckle (page 1 of 2)

Showy yellow flowers held in small [cymes](#).



Individual flowers are tubular to funnel shaped and fairly regular in shape. Petals are pale yellow.



The fruit is an elongated [capsule](#) that flares out into long tips.



The [opposite](#) leaves are simple, ovate-lanceolate. The leaves have finely serrated [margins](#).
